MUND SEEKS TO BE NORTH DAKOTA'S FIRST FEMALE IN THE U.S. HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES



BISMARCK, ND (August 6, 2022) – Cara Mund is seeking petition/certificate of nomination for Congress on the November 8, 2022 General Election ballot as an independent. To be placed on the ballot, Mund needs the signatures of 1,000 qualified North Dakota electors.

Mund chose to make the announcement today on the 57th anniversary of the Voting Rights Act of 1965. If on the ballot and elected, Mund would become North Dakota's first female representative in the United States House of Representatives.

A law school graduate and community leader, Mund was born and raised in North Dakota. She is an honors graduate from Harvard Law School and Brown University. She previously represented the state as North Dakota's first and only Miss America.

"I am so proud to be a North Dakotan" said Mund. "It would be an honor and a privilege to represent the people of our state in Congress. I am ready to get to work and look forward to putting North Dakotans first."
